

COMMUNIQUE

IMPORTATION OF TABLE SALT

It is brought to the attention of traders/importers that applications for import permit for the importation of table salt for the year 2014 will be received at the Trade Division of the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection as from Friday 3 January 2014 under the TradeNet Phase 5 System. The date limit for the submission of such applications is **31 January 2014.**

2. Applicants are also requested to call in person at the Trade Division of the Ministry, 4th Floor, Anglo Mauritius Building, Intendance Street, Port Louis to submit the following documents (original and photocopy) -

- (i) National Identity Card of applicant;
- (ii) Certificate of Incorporation of company or the company's licence, as appropriate;
- (iii) Trading Licence (Foodstuff); and
- (iv) A certified statement confirming storage and distribution facilities for table salt.

Please note that the electronic Job Number of the application should be inscribed on each of the above-mentioned documents.

3. Import permit will be issued subject to the condition that the salt should be imported in packets of not more than 1kg and should comply with the specifications as laid down in the Food Act.

4. The Ministry shall not consider applications-

- (a) received after 31 January 2014.
- (b) submitted without the supporting documents mentioned at paragraph 2 above; and
- (c) from traders/importers who do not have storage and distribution facilities.

5. The Ministry reserves the right to seek additional informational from applicants.
