

Removal of Export Permits

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection wishes to inform the public that the Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 have been promulgated and are effective as from 10 December 2013.

Consequently, the three items listed below have been removed from the List of Controlled Goods and will no longer require an export permit from the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection:-

- 1) Sugar Confectioneries and products with sugar content;
- 2) Fruit juice; and
- 3) Non-alcoholic beverages (soft drinks).
